

Declare Maintada VDC as ODF Zone Project

Project Duration: January – December 2013

Aim:

To declare Maintada VDC as Open Defecation Free zone by 2014.

Project Description:

The Government of Nepal (GoN) has set a target for achieving total sanitation in Surkhet District by 2014. ENPHO, hence, supported the government's plan through the project "Declare Maintada VDC as ODF Zone by 2014".



Project Outputs:

- Formation of child clubs.
- Construction of 998 Sulav and 104 shared improved latrines.

Beneficiaries:

- Altogether 44,097 individuals benefitted from the project intervention, among which 25.66% were male, 27.25% female and 47.01% children. Among them 26.87% were Dalit and 22.95% were Janajati.
- Total 27 ultra-poor HHs were supported with pan and pipe.

Project Achievement

- Maintada VDC declared as 27th ODF VDC on 30th October, 2013 in collaboration with Su-Swastha project.
