### **Aim:**

To support promotion of sustainable sanitation and hygiene.

### **Project Description:**

USSH4A (Urban Sustainable Sanitation and Hygiene for All) project focuses to improve the health and quality of life by increasing access to sustainable sanitation and hygiene in the urban area.



### **Project Outputs:**

- Sanitation demand creation and behavioral change.
- Sanitation services and business development.
- Improving WASH governance, regulating and bringing stakeholders into compliance.
- Improve fecal sludge and waste water management through treatment, disposal and re-use.
- Learning, documentation and sharing of best practices.
- Establishment of hand washing facilities at two schools in Birendranagar Municipality.
- Preparation of O & M guidelines of public toilet.
- Preparation of City Sanitation Strategy.
- Compilation and publication of case studies.

### **Beneficiaries:**

- 18091 local people have access to improved sanitation.
- 1859 students, teachers and WWASHCC members have access to hand washing facilities.
- Among the total benefited around 51% were female.

- Ward 2 (18<sup>th</sup> December 2013), Ward 7 (1<sup>st</sup> June 2013) and Ward 11 (2<sup>nd</sup> September 2013) of Birendranagar Municipality declared as ODF
