Environment and Public Health Organization (ENPHO), established in 1990, is a service-oriented, scientific, national non-government organization that envisages contributing in sustainable community development by combining research and action through integrated programs in the areas of water, sanitation, environment and public health. ENPHO has already worked in all districts of Nepal. ENPHO runs a government accredited laboratory that provides various services for testing water, waste water and soil.

ENPHO is working in close partnership with government agencies, donors, partners and local communities to:

- develop appropriate technologies;
- demonstrate eco-friendly technologies and practices;
- disseminate eco-friendly technologies such as SODIS, ECOSAN toilets and waste water treatment through reed bed systems;
- develop and promote integrated community based approaches that ensure safe water, sustainable sanitation, solid waste management, hygiene behavior and reduction in indoor air pollution to create healthy societies.


To celebrate completion of its 25-year journey, ENPHO is organizing “Silver Jubilee Week” that coincides with the World Water Week in March 2016 with special events.

Event Highlights

- **Day 1 (17 March, 2016) : Inauguration of the Silver Jubilee Week and Deepawali**
ENPHO WASH Centre will be opened formally. The WASH Center will remain open during the week for general public. The WASH Centre will showcase various practical techniques and technologies related to safe water, better sanitation, hygiene, reduction of indoor air pollution and DRR. The WASH Centre will also incorporate WASH Information and Resource Centre. DEEPAWALI will be done at central and field offices on the first day of celebration week at evening.
- **Day 2 (18 March, 2016) : Water Quality Testing Campaign**
Water quality testing campaign will be conducted within Kathmandu valley. ENPHO staff and volunteers will be mobilized for water quality testing at different locations and enhancing public awareness about water safety.



- **Day 3, 4, 5 (19-21 March, 2016) : WASH Campaign**
WASH campaign will be conducted in Kathmandu, Lalitpur and Bhaktapur districts for three consecutive days. WASH stalls will be setup at strategic locations to disseminate WASH related information to the public.



Street drama will be organized for raising public awareness about WASH.

- **Day 6 (24 March, 2016) : Field observation and talk program**
Half day field visit will be organized to observe different WASH related activities on the ground and available technologies at ENPHO WASH Centre. At the end of the visit, a talk program will be organized on WASH in households, community and during emergencies.
- **Day 7 (25 March, 2016) : Closing Ceremony**
ENPHO's 25-year Celebration Week will culminate with a special closing ceremony attended by invited guests that include officials from government agencies, partner organizations, Board members, staff and general members of ENPHO family.
- **Celebration at districts**
In addition to the central level celebration events, ENPHO Field Offices at districts will organize series of celebration events on WASH.
