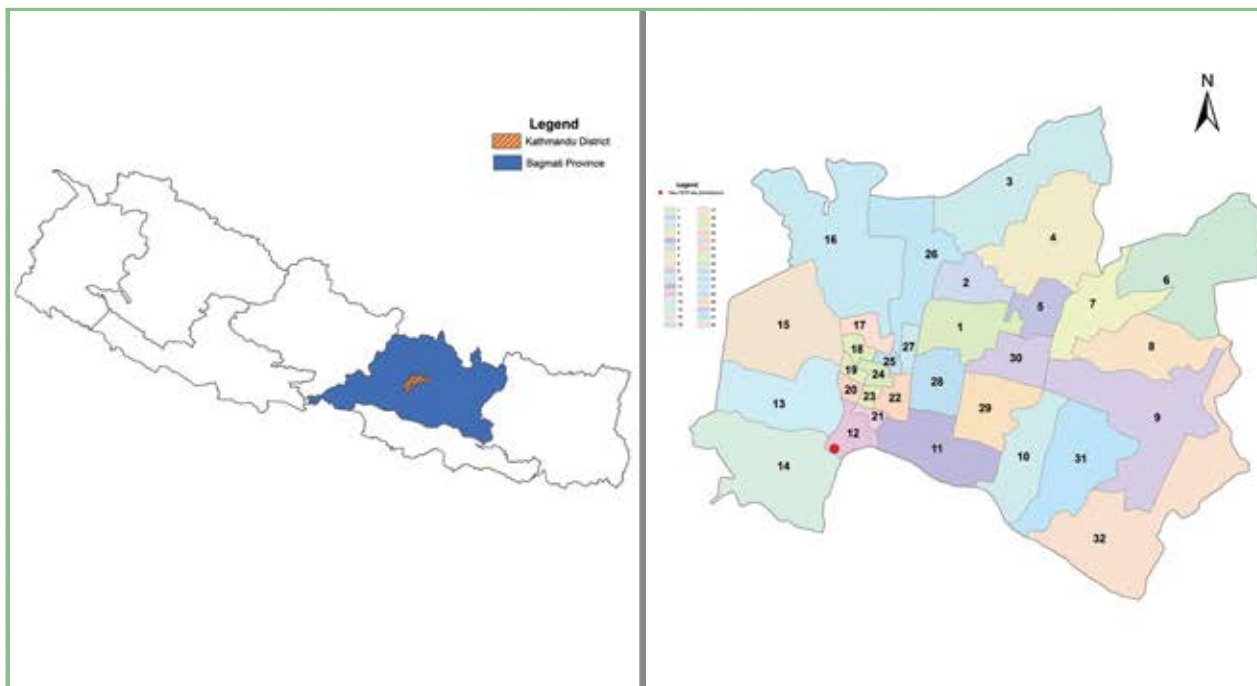


Factsheet of FTSP at Teku, Kathmandu

The Faecal Sludge Treatment Plant (FSTP) located at Teku of Kathmandu Metropolitan City was constructed in 1998 A.D. with financial support from Asian Development Bank (ADB).

At present, the structure has been demolished and is not available for FS treatment facility.
