



Online Training on Drinking Water Quality Testing (DWQT)

About the training

A self-paced online training delivered through CAWST's Learning Management System (LMS), designed to build practical knowledge and hands-on skills in drinking water quality testing. The course focuses on the use of portable testing kits, including the Wagtech Potatest Kit and the ENPHO Test Kit, to assess physical, chemical, and microbiological parameters of drinking water. It also covers water sampling methods, sanitary inspections, basic health and safety practices, and an introduction to WHO guidelines and the National Drinking Water Quality Standards 2079, enabling participants to accurately interpret and report water quality data for real-world application.

- Introduction to drinking water quality testing (DWQT), Aspects of DWQT
- Water Sampling Procedures
- Microbiological Testing Methods
- Turbidity
- Chemical Testing Methods
- Concentrations and Unit Conversions
- Interpreting Results
