


# Training on Wash'Em Approach

## OVERVIEW

This 3-day intensive training, organized by ENPHO in coordination with Shanti Nepal, empowers participants with practical skills to design evidence-based, context-adapted handwashing behavior change programs for emergencies crisis including pandemics, earthquakes, floods, and displacement.

- Use the Wash'Em rapid-assessment tools to collect information about the community
- Analyze the data collected through the Wash'Em tools
- Use the Program Designer to generate context-specific recommendations for a handwashing intervention
